

Congrats! You've taken the next step to promoting your board certification. In addition to providing you with a customizable template, we have included instructions on how to edit your web graphic.

Instructions

1. Extract and save all of the files within the zipped folder to your computer.
2. Before opening the design file, you may need to install the fonts included in the zipped download.
3. Using your preferred graphic editor, open the .psd file. Recommendations: Adobe Photoshop, using a purchased license or free trial, or Photopea.com, which is a free online editor.
4. Once you've opened the file using your preferred editor, change the [PROFESSIONAL'S NAME] text layer by double clicking or selecting the text tool along the left toolbar and clicking the text. Once you select the text to replace, type your name as you'd like it displayed.



5. Once completed, you must now select Export, which is normally found under "File." Export the file using the jpg option as this format is preferred for web and social media. Save the final product on your computer.
6. Open the final image from your computer to make sure everything looks great and then upload the graphic to your website. The 728 x 90 pixel leaderboard web graphic is generally found at the top of a webpage!
